

## What is the Nurture Nest?

The Nurture Nest is a safe, quiet, nurturing, happy place. The children visit in small groups on a daily basis, for approximately 1hr 30 minutes. Our Nurture group is organised around a structured and predictable timetable. We provide educational provision whilst making the important link between emotional needs and cognitive learning at their level.



## What activities happen in the Nurture Nest?

The Nurture room is arranged as a homely classroom with many areas such as a home corner, quiet area, book area, sand, water, writing and book area.

Through play and focused tasks the children will develop important social skills as well as being engaged in curriculum based activities, similar to classroom provision.



## Why might my child visit the Nurture Nest?

Sometimes children need extra support to help them with their learning, making friends and growing into confident and successful individuals.

Nurture groups can help provide that support for children to give them the skills they need to do well at school, and deal more confidently and calmly with the trials and tribulations of everyday life.
