Reading at home

Reading underpins the Year 1 curriculum and is paramount to their life-long learning. Children who are supported at home with their reading make much greater progress. **We strongly recommend reading with your child daily at home for at least 10 minutes.**

Our Learning

In Literacy, we shall be focusing on descriptive writing and recounts. We will be reading the book ‘Peepo’ by Janet and Allan Ahlberg.

We will work hard on letter formation and handwriting, making sure that all of our letters are correctly formed.

We are also focusing on children using capital letters, full stops and finger spaces in their writing.

We will have daily phonic sessions; working from your child’s starting point.

In Maths, we are going to be learning about place value and the number system.

We will be practising counting forwards and backwards with numbers to 100.
