



Year 6 Learning Leaflet



English

Our English this term will be based around Macbeth in our first 2 weeks. We will be focusing on drama, prediction and writing letters in roles.

The second part of the half term will be focussed on the book Pig Heart Boy which explores heart transplantation. We will be writing a balanced argument and poems.

In Guided Reading, we will be focusing on developing the pupils' ability to answer questions found in SATs.

Spelling and grammar work will continue to take place regularly.

Maths

The children will continue to develop and apply their number, place value and calculation skills by:

Solving algebraic problems.

Calculating area, & perimeter of triangles, parallelograms and compound shapes. Children will also learn how to calculate the volume of cubes and cuboids.

Converting between units of measurement.

Solving problems involving ratio.

Developing their knowledge of the properties of a wide range of 2D and 3D shapes.

Solving problems involving statistical data.

Regular arithmetic work.

Shakespeare and Blood Heart

The second half of the Spring term sees year 6 learning about 2 main topics. The first mini-topic is William Shakespeare. We are learning about him in preparation for the Young Shakespeare Company's visit in the second week of the term. The children will be learning about Shakespeare's life and what he was famous for.

The second part of the half term will see the children learning about the circulatory system in our topic Blood Heart. This topic is a science focussed one with plenty of opportunities to investigate scientifically. The children will be learning about how the circulatory system works, how to measure heart rates and how to keep their heart healthy.
