Wednesday	u – Teach the sound 'u' Word Association: uuuunder, uuupset, uuumbrella Ted Talk: m-u-d, c-u-p, c-u-t, j-u-g	Reading: Look at some food packaging for any sounds that we have learnt so far. Writing: Draw a picture of your favourite toy and label it.	Count to 10. Use your fingers to count to 10. How many hands does it take to make 10?	CREATE: Choose an idea from the home learning curriculum news
Thursday	r – Teach the sound 'r'	Reading: Read a story book of choice.	Gather 5 objects from the kitchen. Hide 1 – how many are left now?	SONG: Sing a topic song from the home learning curriculum news
