- Frequently Asked Questions

Q. Will Parents be able to visit school and the Early Years unit?

A. Yes! We are in the exciting process of having a new school built, therefore all of our visits and transition events will be taking place in September 2021, at the new school site – watch this space!

Q. How will I know what your school has to offer without visiting?

Q. When is the deadline to apply for a school place?

A. The online admissions system is available for reception applications from 9th November 2020 until 15th January 2021 for children born between 1st September 2016 and 31st August 2017.

Q. When will I find out about my child's school place?

A. If you apply online for a primary school place, you will receive an email on 16 April 2021 telling you which school your child has been offered (unless you opted out of this service). If you applied late on a paper form you will be sent a letter telling you which school has been offered.

Q. Do I need to make contact with the school?

A. No. As a school we will be in touch with all parents who have successfully been granted a Reception place for September 2021. This will be shortly after 16th April 2021.
