

Year 1 Learning Leaflet

Topic

Art and Design - We will be looking at the art work of the author and illustrator Bethan Woolvin the creator of 'Little Red'. We will create woodland scenes in her style using only three colours.

We will be looking at Andy Goldsworthy's natural sculptures and creating our own land art!

ICT– We will use different animation methods to create an animation of the growth of a flower. We will use the iPads to make stop motion animations and 2Animate on Purple Mash.

PSHE–Valuing Difference.

Geography—School trip to the Nell Bank to explore the woodland and its features first hand.

We will use geographical vocabulary to describe key physical features such as hill, soil, woods, stream and trees.

PE– Participating in team games, developing simple tactics for attacking and defending. (Dodgeball).

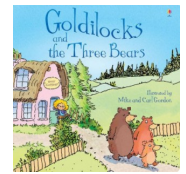

We will become very familiar with traditional tales, retelling them and considering their particular characteristics. We will pay particular attention to the story of **Little Red** by Bethan Woolvin, (an interpretation of the well known story Little Red Riding Hood) as well as the traditional tale Goldilocks and the Three Bears.

RE

Our theme this half term is Judaism. We are learning about Shabbat and understanding why it is an important event in Jewish life.

Science Plants

We will be identifying and naming a variety of common wild and garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees.

We will be identifying and describing the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants, including trees.
