If your child is unable to access the learning for their year group, as they find it too difficult, please look at the same subject from the previous year groups.

As you will appreciate, at this time of year, the learning in Year 6 is fairly flexible and does not follow as strict a timetable as usual.

Activities planned for this week include the following:

Subject	Activities
English	Final formal assessment of Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling. Study of 'The Chocolate Tree' – a version of a Mayan folk tale. The children will build towards writing their own folk tales early next week (12 th July).
Reading	Continuing to enjoy the story of 'Wonder' by RJ Palacio – a novel with clear links to transition to a new school.
Topic ('Hola Mexico')	Planning a design for a 'Sugar Skull' (DT sewing project). Identifying, and exploring, ancient Maya temples in Central America (geography). An introductory Spanish lesson – numbers (languages).
Science	Drawing circuit diagrams. Exploring how the brightness of a bulb and volume of a buzzer is affected by the voltage of cells in a circuit.
Transition activities	Begin to gather memories of their time at Silsden Primary school.
