	Literacy (4 English sessions per week, plus 3 Reading and 2 Spelling or Grammar)	Maths 5 sessions per week	Topic & Science (Darwin's Delight / Evolution and Inheritance – 4 or 5 sessions per week)
Monday	English: Write a cliffhanger for the end of chapter 7 of Darwin's Dragons.	Number and Place Value: Rounding any number (Reasoning and Problem solving)	Topic 1. The Beagle Diaries – Looking at Darwin's notes and sketches. How did he turn these into theories over time? Science 2. How do species adapt to different habitats? (Looking at animals such as the marine iguana and the blue-footed booby) 3. Beak investigation – Investigating how a bird's beak is designed to eat foods (using pegs, tweezers and chopsticks as beaks).
