Topic

Art and Design - Greek pottery

Computing—Use a variety of software on a range of digital devices to create content.

Geography—Locating Greece. Researching and comparing climate zones.

History— Greek Gods and Goddesses, Famous Greeks, everyday life in ancient Greece, Myths and legends, the birth of the Olympics.

Maths

This half term we will be focusing on Money, multiplication and division.

We will be continuing to practice column addition and subtraction of 3-digit numbers. We will also be learning our 3, 4 and 8 times tables so remember to go on TTRS regularly!

Gods and Mortals

This half term we will be stepping back in time to discover the fantastical world of Ancient Greece, full of mythical creatures and legendary heroes. We will find out what life was like for mortals during this period of history and who the Greek Gods were. We've got lots of fun activities planned, starting with an exciting hook into our topic.

English

To start this half term we are going to be writing our own fact file based on a mythical creature.

We will finish the term exploring a festive story containing even more mythical creatures.

RE—Children will be learning thinking about the festive season and thinking about the following question: “Has Christmas lost its true meaning?”

French— Days, months, colours and numbers

Music—Exploring musical elements.
