Monday	h – Teach the sound 'h' Word Association: hhhhhorse, hhhhhhen, hhhhhat Ted Talk: h-e-n, h-i-t, h-o-p, h-a-t	Read the book The Jolly Postman or Other People's Letters by Janet and Alan Ahlberg. Read the traditional tale – Goldilocks and the 3 Bears. Can you find objects in your house that are big, medium and small?
Tuesday	b – Teach the sound 'b' Word Association: bbbbboot, bbbball, bbbbicycle, bbbbbaag Ted Talk: b-i-n, b-a-d, b-e-d	Re-read book - Look at all the different types of post that the postman is delivering. E.g. letter, advertisement brocher, postcard, birthday card.	Count 4 objects 1,2,3,4 (Understand the value of 4 e.g. 4 is four objects) Go on a hunt looking for 4 objects counting out – 4 pieces of fruit from the bowl, 4 pieces of Lego, 4 cars etc.	Read the traditional tale - Hansel and Gretel. Make a model of a Ginger Bread house using junk modelling or construction.
Wednesda y	f – Teach the sound 'f' Word Association: fffffish, ffffflower, fffffrog, fffffairy Ted Talk: f-u-n-, f-a-t-, f-i-t, f-a-n	Post vocabulary Look at the envelopes in each part of the story. What is on them all? Stamps, address, envelope.	Represent number 4. What does it look like on a tally, four fingers, 4 dots on a dice, 4 table legs, 4 chair legs, 4 legs on dog, 4 pennies etc.	Read the traditional tale – Jack and the Beanstalk. Discuss how Jack was small and the Giant was really big.

		Look at some letters in your home and see if they have the same.		Can you find objects that are bigger than you in your house? What are you bigger than?
Thursday	ff – Teach the sound 'ff' <i>Word Association:</i> huffffff, puffffff <i>Ted Talk:</i> h-u-ff, p-u-ff	<u>Comprehension</u> Draw a story map with the children to show the Jolly Postman's journey and where he goes to deliver his letters. Draw or use pictures from book.	Look at shapes and see if you can find any with 4 sides. Go on a shape hunt – how many squares can you find in the environment.	Read the traditional tale – Cinderella
Friday	Recap all 4 sounds learnt this week h, b, f, ff	Introduce the term settings – Start at the beginning and look for clues in the story. Where do the bears live? Where does the witch live etc. Draw a picture of your favourite setting. Which character lives there.	Learning how to make 4. Investigate all the different ways of making 4. Use a set of objects and split them into different groups. Can you record all the different ways you made 4.	Read the traditional tale – Little Red Riding Hood.
