Follow a recipe together and then ice them.
Wednesday	x – Teach the sound 'x' Word Association: xxxexercise, xxxexplotion, xxxexperiment Ted Talk: f-o-x, b-o-x Letter formation: down the arm and leg and repeat the other side	Make your own story map of the Jolly Christmas postman. Add the settings in the order that they come in.	Can you find things in the house that represent 5? A glove, a car with 5 seats, a picture of a gate. Draw around your hand on a piece of paper? Can you count the 5 fingers?	Draw or paint a picture of the nativity, or your favourite character.

Are there any new ones compared to the first book ‘The Jolly Postman?’	<p>Can you get 5 sticks, or straws, or paper strips and make a shape? What shape have you made? (A Pentagon)</p> <p>Can you make a star shape with 5 points?</p>	Which Christmas songs do you sing at home? Do you family know any Christmas songs?
Friday	Recap all 4 sounds learnt this week v, w, x, y	Write a Christmas list to Santa. Try and sound out the words of the things you would like to get.	Can you write number 5? Try and practice writing different sized number 5.	Try doing an ice experiment. Does it melt inside? Pop it outside. Pop it next to a radiator, what happens?
