

Creative Home Learning Ideas

Below are some creative home learning ideas based around our next topic. Please read the ideas to your child and let them choose which activities they would like to complete at home with you or on their own. Try to complete at least 2 activities by the end of the half-term. We would love to see your amazing home learning so make sure you send us photos on dojo or bring it in to school so that it can be shared with your class.

- Create your own 3D solar system model- can you also name some of the planets?
- Create your own 3D rocket – can you use your science knowledge on materials to build the strongest and fastest rocket for Baby Bear?
- Draw your own solar system – possible materials to use: watercolours, chalk, paint, pencils.
- Find out the names of each planet in the solar system and place them in order, based on their distance from the sun.
- Create your own space helmet – will you be ready to fly to the moon with Baby Bear?
- Can you create a matching space suit too?
- Choose your favourite planet from the solar system and create a fact file. How can you make your fact file different from others?
- Create a fact file or poster on Neil Armstrong – what new facts can you learn to share with your class?
- Can you find out who else has travelled to the moon, alongside and after Neil Armstrong?
- Constellations are shapes made by stars in the night. Using the app 'Star tracker', find out the names of different constellations and create a picture or model to represent these.
- Use a range of materials to make a model of a lunar vehicle. Make sure to bring it to school for Baby Bear to test drive!
- Visit BBC Bitesize KS1- The Moon and watch the video attached. Using the information from the video, can you write some sentences to explain what you have learnt?
- Have you got a telescope? Watch the sky at night and write some descriptive sentences, using adjectives, to explain what you can see.
