## Home Learning Ideas

**Below are some ideas based around our new topic. Please read the ideas to your child and let them choose which activities they would like to complete at home with you or on their own. Try to complete at least 2 activities by the end of the half-term. Make sure you bring your home learning in throughout the half term so that it can be displayed.**

### Flow

- Design a new boat for Mr Toad and make a 3D model.
- Research an artist who has created a picture of a river and try to recreate it.
- Research the purpose of your local canal and river. What were they used for? How has this changed over time?
- Find a local source of water. What do you notice about it? What wildlife lives there? What plants grow there?
- Write a shape poem about a river.

### Plants

- Create a collage out of foraged materials.
- Create a 3D plant out of materials you have at home e.g. junk modelling, Lego, playdough.
- Grow your own plant at home and document it over the half term.
- How many different types of flowers can you see on your walk to school? Do these change? Create a table to show your evidence.
- Make a miniature garden that includes different types of plants.
