Creative Home Learning Ideas

The Enchanted Woodland



Below are some creative home learning ideas based around our next topic. Please read the ideas to your child and let them choose which activities they would like to complete at home with you or on their own. Try to complete at least 2 activities by the end of the half-term. We would love to see your amazing home learning so make sure you send us photos on dojo or bring it in to school so that it can be shared with your class.

- Plant some seeds (if available to you). Draw and write a plant diary about the changes you see each week.
- Make patterns and sculptures using natural materials in your garden. Take photographs of your artwork.
- Make miniature homes and gardens for minibeasts and fairies from natural materials such as bark, pebbles, twigs, leaves and pine cones.
- Search the web or look in books to find out what animals live in woodlands or forests in the UK. Choose your favourite animal and write some interesting facts about it.
- Write a letter to Mr Fox telling him what you have been doing at school and at home. He'd love to hear about your adventures!
- Measure the length or height of small trees or bushes, sticks, twigs and leaves found in your garden, local park or woodland.
- Create a gingerbread house for a fairy-tale character.
- Create sock puppets and re-tell your favourite fairy-tale story.
- Write a recipe for Gruffalo crumble.
- Create a garden gnome.
- Paint story spoons for each character in The Gruffalo.
- Make a headband for your favourite Gruffalo character.
