# Year 1 Learning Leaflet

## Land Ahoy!

### Maths

This half-term in Maths we will be focusing on numbers up to 100. The children will practice reading, writing and counting up to 100 and develop a secure understanding of the place value of tens and ones. The children will apply their mathematical fluency skills that they have been working on across the year to reasoning and problem-solving questions. Over the term we will also look at other units of measure, such as the value of money and time.

### PSHCE/RE/Music

PSHCE – Our PSHCE learning this half-term will be around the theme Growing and Changing.

RE – Our learning will be around the key question of: What can Muslim children learn about Islam from the Qur'an?

Music – Performing together.  
Developing good singing voices!

### Science

This half-term in Science we will continue our learning about Plants before returning to our previous topic looking at materials. The children will be able to identify, name and sort a variety of everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water, and rock. The children will secure and expand their knowledge of a materials properties and will be able to compare materials based on their physical properties.

### About this topic

Our final topic in Year 1 will be...  
Pirates! Why do pirates need pirate ships?

We are looking forward to seeing some super creative final pieces of home learning.



### English

For the first part of the term, the children will be focusing on the book 'The Night Pirates' by Peter Harris. During this topic the children will write a poem focused around their senses, including what they would be able to see and hear if they were on a pirate ship. They will also have a go at writing a diary entry from the point of view of Tom. Our second text will be 'The Pirates Are Coming' by John Condon. They will use the book to write a short narrative continuing to apply the skills we have learnt this year. Please continue to read with your child at home as we continue to build on their reading fluency and early comprehension skills.

### Topic

Art and Design – Pirate portraits and Pirate Flags. Our artist study will be Hokusai, focusing on The Great Wave picture.

Design Technology – Creating boats.

Geography – The children will be able to name and locate the 4 countries in the UK and surrounding seas.

History – We will be learning about a significant individual, Captain Hook.

PE – Athletics in preparation for our sports day!

Computing – This half term the children will have opportunity to create simple programmes and test these out on our BeeBots.
