English

Our final work of the year will link to our Mayan history topic and will provide the Children with the opportunity to write their own folk tales inspired by Gods, Goddesses and legends.

Our class story will be the fabulous story, 'Wonder' by RJ Palacio. This book fits very well with the idea of transition and moving on.
