### Year 4 Swimming – Turing Class

11<sup>th</sup> July 2022

Dear Parent or Carer,

As part of the National Curriculum for PE, each class in Year 4 will be going swimming to Skipton Swimming Pool on Monday afternoons for one term. **Turing** begin their sessions on **Monday, 12<sup>th</sup> September 2022** with an assessment of their swimming abilities.

The sessions will enable your child to achieve the National Curriculum expected standard before the end of Year 4. (The main requirement: to swim unaided for 25 metres.) Your child will be expected to attend every session in order to achieve this standard.

Each week, your child will need:

- Swimming costume (**not** bikini or baggy swimming/board shorts)
- Towel
- Swimming hat (if hair is shoulder length or longer)
- Waterproof bag
- Inhaler or other medication
- Goggles – not compulsory but may be of use
- For speed and ease of changing, girls should avoid wearing tights on Mondays

It will be important that your child lets us know as soon as possible on a Monday morning if they forget their kit so that alternative arrangements can be made.

Children should return to school for normal dismissal between 15:20 – 15:30 but please note that traffic delays may lead to their being a few minutes back to school.
