Maths

Maths in our final term will consolidate the children's general arithmetic skills of addition and subtraction, within 20. We will also introduce the measurements of money and time.

Science

This half-term in Science we will be recapping the topic 'Everyday Materials'. The children will be developing their understanding of working scientifically to conduct fair tests focusing on the



PSHE/RE/Music

PSHE – All our PSHE learning this half-term will be around the theme 'Growing and Changing'.

RE – What can Muslim children learn about Islam from the Qur'an?

Music – Exploring music focusing on rhythm, pitch and genre.



Writing

This half-term in English we will be exploring the texts Supertato by Sue Hendra and A Superhero Like You by Dr Ranj. We will use these texts to consolidate our learning this year. We will use 'think it, say it, write it, check it' to write stories containing a range of interesting adjectives, punctuation and suffixes.

Reading/Phonics

This half-term it will be the National Phonics Screening Check in Y1. The check will take place on w/c Monday 10th June 2024. Our daily phonics sessions will continue and every day counts so please make sure you keep up your good attendance! We will continue to develop our reading fluency and become more confident in answering simple comprehension questions about the texts we read. Please continue to practise your phonics and reading skills at home to help your child prepare.

Topic

Art and Design – Draw a superhero identity self-portrait. Study the work of Roy Lichtenstein artist and create some Pop Art.

Design Technology – Design, make and evaluate a fruit kebab.

Geography – Discover the key human features in and around Silsden. Draw a simple map with some symbols.

History – Learn about Florence Nightingale and investigate how hospitals have changed over time.
