Year 5 Learning Leaflet



<u>English</u>

In the first unit of this half term we will be writing a narrative from the viewpoint of the children's favourite sportsman. We will be using present perfect and present progressive tense throughout and recapping parenthesis and relative clauses.

In the second unit of the half term, children will be creating a fact file on how to compete in their favourite sport. We are going to give the children freedom with this write, giving them the option to choose from all the skills they have learnt in Year 5.

<u>Maths</u>

In this final half-term, we will be focusing on finishing our Maths units for the year. We will focus first on position and direction, decimals, negative number and converting units.

We will be continuing with our weekly arithmetic tests, which will consolidate their learning from the entire year.

Please also keep up the times table practice at home as this will help the children start Year 6 in the best possible way.

<u>Topic</u>
