



Dear Parents and Carers,

As we once again reach the end of the summer term I would like to express my thanks to all of our staff and children for all of the hard work that they have done this year. So many children have made fantastic progress and there have been super end of year results across the school. These show that our school is doing well and that academically Silsden children perform as well as, or better than their peers nationally. The results also show how the efforts of the staff are improving outcomes for children year on year.

The below table shows the current headline attainment figures for our school over the last three years.

Again this year we have made a huge effort to encourage good attendance in school. Our school attendance for the year is 95.5% which is well over the 94.2% nationally. There has also been a large increase in the number of children with 100% attendance. This number has increased from 34 children last year to 60 this year. This is a great achievement and something that these children should be really proud of.

The children have all had transition time with their new teachers and classrooms ready for next year. Parents are already aware from my letter of 25th June of the staff that will be leaving us and the new appointments that have been made ready for September.
