The Age of Stone and Iron

Welcome to Year 3! We can't wait to get immersed into our new topic: Stone Age! This leaflet will tell you all about what your child will be learning this half term. The children will be learning all about the Stone Age, how people lived, what they ate, what they believed, their tools, weapons and their art. They will be creating art work in the style of cave drawings and will be attempting to make tools, make shelters and perhaps even cook cave -man style!

English

This half term we will be exploring a range of books with a stone age theme, including Stone Age Boy, Ug, and Little Nose. We'll be using some of these and non-fiction books to lead our reading club sessions. We will be writing vivid descriptions of cave homes and about the skills we would need to survive in the Stone Age..

Maths

This term in Maths the children will learn about :

- Place Value up to 1000.
- Addition and subtraction using formal column methods.



RE

In RE this half term the children will be thinking about the following question: Would celebrating Divali bring a sense of belonging to a Hindu?
