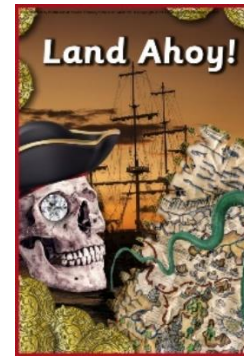
Where can you find a pirate ship?

In our first topic we will be exploring the 5 oceans. We will be creating some pirate themed artwork and singing some pirate songs.

Maths

This half-term in Maths we will be focusing on numbers within 10. The children will be looking at the place value of these numbers and then they will apply them when adding.

We will also introduce the children to NumBots this is an online maths game that supports them in building the foundations of their mathematical knowledge.

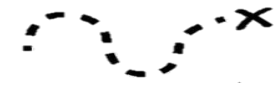


PSHE/RE/PE

PSHE – All our PSHE learning this half-term will be around the theme 'Me and My Relationships'.

RE – Who created the world?

PE – Fundamentals and Ball Skills.



Science

This half-term in Science we will be focusing on the topic 'Animals including Humans'. The children will be learning to identify, name and label the basic parts of the human body. They will also be exploring their senses and learning which body parts these are associated with.

Topic

Art and Design – Draw a pirate portrait. Complete an artist study on Hokusai, recreate The Great Wave using watercolours. Design and create a pirate flag.

Geography – Identify, name and locate the five oceans. Identify, name and locate the four countries of the United Kingdom. Investigate and explore maps. Notice changes to physical features in the autumn.

Outdoor Learning – Use natural materials to make a picture, dam building and basic fire pit safety.

Key Vocabulary – Arctic Ocean, Atlantic Ocean, England, Indian Ocean, Northern Ireland, Pacific Ocean, Scotland, Southern Ocean, Wales

Reading/Phonics

This half-term we will be focusing on developing a love of reading through sharing our favourite stories. We will continue to build our phonetic knowledge through our daily phonics sessions. We will also begin Reading Club sessions which will us to develop our reading fluency.

Writing

This half-term in English we will be exploring the texts The Night Pirates by Peter Harris and The Pirates are Coming by John Condon. We will focus on developing our use of 'think it, say it, write it, check it' to write sentences that have capital letters, full stops, finger spaces and phonics for spelling. We will then introduce the conjunction 'and' and the suffix 'ing'.

This half-term our Computing, Music and Languages lessons will be delivered by Junior Jam.
