English


Our first unit will be linked to the book 'Bog Baby'. We will be recapping Year One skills such as adjectives and the ed suffix.

Our second unit will be based on the book 'The King with Dirty Feet' and out final unit will be based on the book 'Lost and Found.'


Maths

In Maths this half term we will be focussing mainly on place value. We will start this by recapping Year One learning before moving on to using a place value chart to recognise the value of digits up to 100. We will then move on to writing numbers in words and using a number line to estimate numbers. We will finish this unit by comparing objects and numbers before then ordering them. In preparation for are upcoming multiplication units we will start to introduce counting in 2s, 5s and 10s to the children. After this, we will move onto the addition and subtraction unit where will recap number bonds to twenty and apply this learning to number bonds to 100. Please make sure that your child is still playing Numbots as it is very important to the first two units of the year.
