Parents whose children are on the SEND register will be able to book a 20-minute appointment. This is necessary as you will be discussing the review and update of your child's I.E.P and their progress towards their targets.

You will also be able to view your child's I.E.P review and update online before the meeting so that you know what will be discussed and have the opportunity to consider the information that they contain. We will be writing to you separately with information about how you can access this.

The booking system will go live for parents whose children are on the SEND register to book their 20 minute appointments on Monday 10th February at 6pm

The booking system will go live for all other parents to book their appointments on Thursday 13th February at 9.00am

You will also be receiving your mid-term report before the half term. This report should give you an idea of how your child is doing at school in some key areas around learning behaviour and attitude, attendance and reading. This should help formulate some of the discussions with your child's teachers.
