Topic

Art and Design - Artist studies: We will be creating a collaborative art piece in the style of Turner.

Design Technology - We will be creating 3d models of the Wharfe valley, understanding contours and how rivers form landscape

Geography—Rivers around the world, features of rivers, flooding and areas in the world without water.
